BACKGROUND:

The Streets Master Plan builds on the City's General Plan and previously adopted plans and studies to create a comprehensive document intended to guide decision-making, funding, and interdepartmental coordination over time regarding how people move around St. Helena in all modes: walking, biking, or driving. The Plan is a comprehensive set of proposed projects, prioritized by community input and community benefit.

The online PDF allows the public to make comments within the document to best facilitate the City's and Consultant's accumulation of comments and responses.
